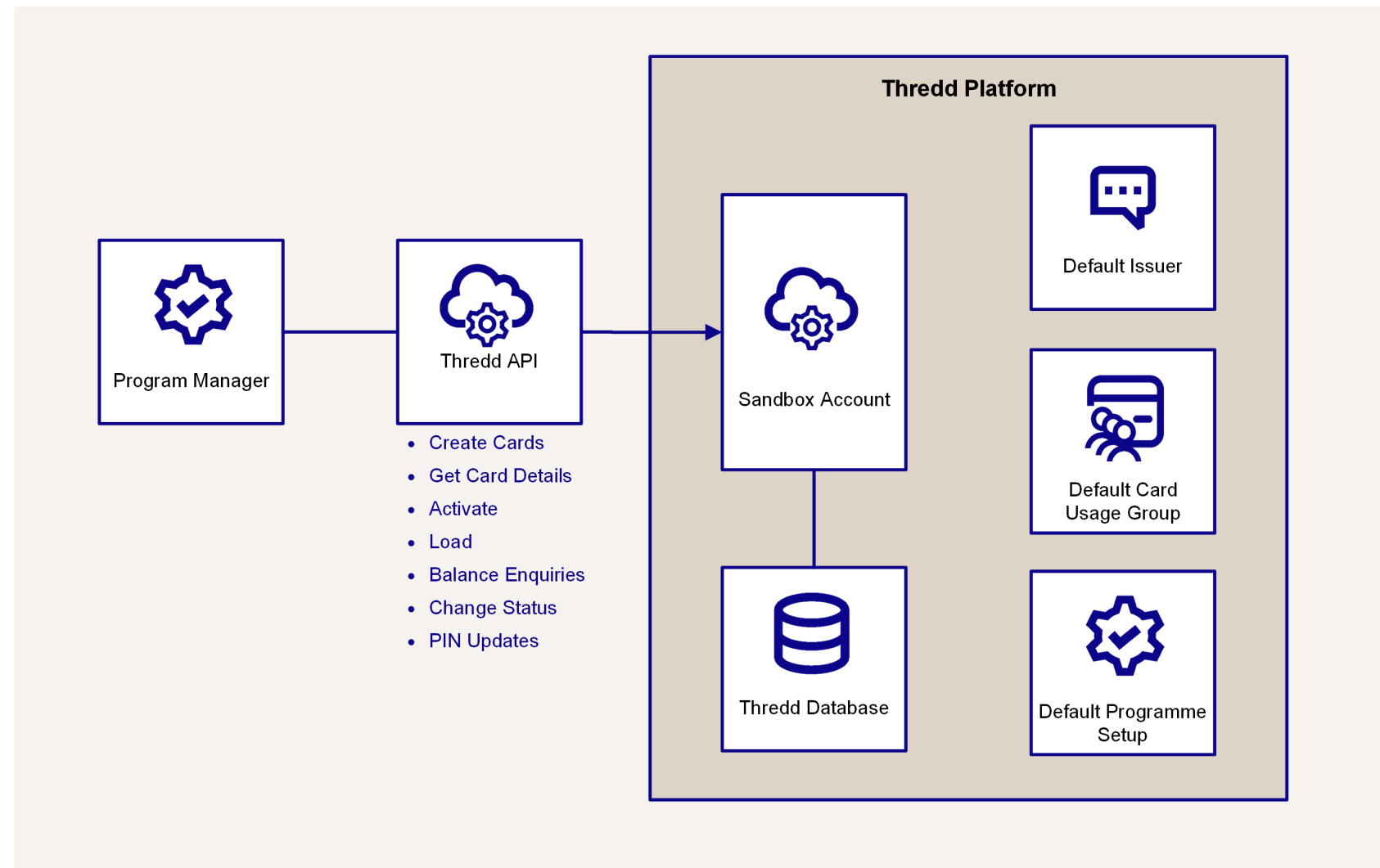
Try out our flexible API in the Thredd UAT environment

The Sandbox is a generic shared test account, set up with a default issuer and a basic card program. It provides access to an environment to help you discover how the Thredd API works and enables you to create and manage test cards.

Access to the Sandbox allows you to begin using the Thredd REST-based API to explore the Thredd cards functionality. This will help you refine your requirements and project scope at the earliest opportunity.

When you sign up for an account on our [Developer Portal](#), you will receive credentials that allow you to use the Sandbox. Note that test data in the Sandbox is visible to other users and is not unique. Test cards that are created in the Sandbox are not sent for printing and there is no connection or processing via the card schemes.

The basic configuration includes a Physical Product and a Virtual Product (both with GBP only and UK Country of Issue). Each Product has an associated Velocity Limit Group and Card Usage Group.
